Kabbalah Timeline

The JKM will display a timeline of the Kabbalah from its inception through modern day. This will include a detailed description of most prominent kabbalists, rabbis and scholars of the Kabbalah, their works and accomplishments. The Timeline will allow the museum visitor to walk away with a feeling that it's authentic and relevant to their daily life. The historical overview will link the past to the present.



Holy Temple Ashes

The building in which the JKM is located is over 100 years old. Tradition has it that when digging the foundation of the building, lots of ashes were found in the earth.

It's believed that this location was one of the areas outside of Temple where they brought the leftover ashes from the Temple Altar sacrifices. There was much holy energy in the daily sacrifices and its ashes retained that holiness.



Garments

Jerusalem's Kabbalah and Chasidic communities offer various garments that have deep mystical meaning. At the JKM, you'll see a display of these garments including various head coverings, girdles, hats and robes. Each color and style has a Kabbalah association.



Artifacts

The Jerusalem Kabbalah Museum will display different ancient holy Kabbalah artifacts. These include blessed money, coins, household items and Kabbalah aides.



Holy Books

Kabbalah has thousands of holy books many of which are out of print. At the JKM we'll have a computer program showing these out of print holy books and display some of the ones in print.



Manuscripts

JKM has various manuscripts that are most unique. Because of their high sensitivity, they aren't open to the public but viewable on disk.



Amulets

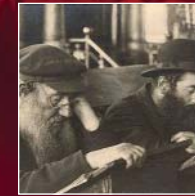
Several holy Kabbalists used money and other items as amulets for good health, wealth and other human needs. At the JKM these will be displayed.

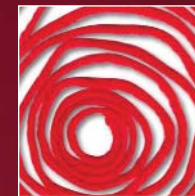
PKT - Personal Kabbalah Trainer

Regression Therapy
