Shabbos Parshas Ki Sisa, 5768 – Purim Katan

This week we celebrated Purim Katan, the small Purim. This year is a leap year, which has two months of Adar. Our holy sages instructed that we celebrate Purim in the second Adar because of the proximity to Passover. Pesach, the redemption of our people from Egyptian exile should follow the redemption of Purim from wicked Haman. Purim Katan, the 14th of Adar 1, is considered a happy day for celebrations.

On Purim the Jewish people demonstrated self sacrifice, standing up to evil Haman. Every Jew has this self sacrifice within the recesses of their heart. Accessing it requires bonding to Torah and Mitzvot. We need to reveal this connection, with joy and happiness.

In honor of Purim we are hosting two major events:

- March 9 we will celebrate our annual gala dinner with our guest speaker Dr. Paul Eidelberg, Ph.D. from Jerusalem. His topic will be, "**What can You do to Save Israel?**" The dinner will help us raise funds for our critical Tzedaka projects, to help the needy families locally and in our holy land of Israel.
